Stewardship of Giving Commitment Card

Take a step!

To move steadily toward giving that is **planned, proportionate** and **sacrificial**.

- ◇ Find your household income
- ◇ Move across **that row** to find the amount you currently give weekly
- ◇ Move up that column to find the current percentage of your gift

Prayerfully consider **Taking a Step** and committing at the next percentage level (column to the right). For example if you have been giving 2.5% to the parish; consider 3% or 3.5%

Prayerfully consider setting your eventual goal at the biblical tithe of 10%. It may take a few years but you'll make progress by **Taking a Step**.

We ask that you split your tithe with other charities such as our Mortgage Reduction (Diocesan Charity and Development Appeal, St Vincent de Paul, etc.). E.g. if you are giving 5% through the parish's weekly envelopes, we ask that you give 5% to other charities.
